Subject: Citizens Air Complaint Program

Dear Mr. Mayor,

On behalf of the undersigned businesses, we write regarding the Citizens Air Complaint Program. We have reached a breaking point as the program has completely mushroomed out of control from its original intention. We feel our collective voice regarding concerns with the program has not been heard and the contributions of the trucking industry are being ignored. Nearly 200 businesses that employ tens of thousands of New Yorkers have signed on to this letter to express the significant negative impact this program is having on New York businesses. We represent companies of various sizes, from owner operators to small and medium-sized family-owned businesses to national haulers. While many of us are suppliers who need trucks in the course of our work, we do not consider ourselves "trucking companies." We move essential goods throughout the city and were, in fact, heralded as heroes during the pandemic when truck drivers risked their health and safety to ensure New York City received necessary goods during one of its darkest moments. Many of us employ union labor (40%), represent MWBE ownership (20%), and are intrinsic to the economic vitality of the city, delivering 90% of the goods that

are deeply flawed and causing undue hardship to our businesses. It is clear, we share the NYC Department of Environmental Protection's (NYCDEP) goal to provide a cleaner, more sustainable future and environment for the city's residents. However, we do not accept that this must be at the expense of hard-working individuals and small businesses in the trucking industry.

The Citizens Air Complaint Program in its current form makes us victims of a relentless profit industry and strips us of our right to due process. Some of our issues with the program include inconsistent and untimely summons, lack of notification to the accurate driver or registered owner, the absence of information and evidence provided on a summons, the inability to transfer liability for dealerships or independent contractors, and the willful manipulation of the system to allow for the submission of frivolous complaints. We also question whether the goal of this program, which is to prevent the illegal parking of commercial vehicles, is actually being achieved. A memo which was previously provided to the NYCDEP is included as an addendum to this letter to further detail our concerns and suggested solutions.

We are not just talking the talk; we are walking the walk. We are
